Members and friends of Christ Church Lutheran can do their part to fulfill the vision for our second century with a three-year or five-year pledge, or a one-time gift.


Spreading your gift over a period of time can allow you to be more generous. For example, a \$5,000 pledge paid over five years is less than \$20 per week.

A report prepared by Scott R. Riedel & Associates in 2013 states that the deterioration of our organ requires a major investment in repairs. The more fiscally responsible approach is to replace it soon.

- A well-functioning pipe organ will help us realize our vision for Christ Church to increasingly become a place of exceptional worship and music.
- A better organ will contribute to our vision of vital outreach to the larger community by enabling us to host community services, worship festivals, recitals, and hymn sings.
- A higher-quality organ will enhance our existing external partnerships with musical groups and provide opportunities for additional partnerships.

BUILDING



In 2013, a Historic Structures Report identified a list of necessary and critical projects to preserve and maintain the building for future use. Some of these are quite urgent. Other projects will be undertaken as we are financially able.

Priority projects include:

- Tunnel repairs
- Courtyard restoration
- Improved accessibility
- Entrance plaza restoration
- Arcade column repairs
- Window seals and repairs in sanctuary
- Roof repair
- Repair and refinish wood paneling in sanctuary
- Security improvements
- Additional projects may include energy efficiency improvements and air conditioning

MISSION



In many ways, the organ and building projects of this campaign fulfill important aspects of the vision and mission of Christ Church Lutheran.

In addition to preserving our landmark building, Christ Church Lutheran is committed to including outward-focused mission as a tangible part of this campaign by raising additional funds to direct toward local or global causes.

We will commit ten percent of the congregation's portion of the campaign to missions. Three projects have been selected to receive this support:

- Beacon Interfaith Housing Collaborative Project
- Always Being Made New: The Campaign for the ELCA
- Lutheran Social Services' Metro Homeless Youth Program
