With thankfulness for the people of our past, we celebrate our bountiful blessings as we gather in this sacred space to continue serving our loving God. During the year, we will honor the many congregational ministries at CCL begun years ago and now transformed to meet today's needs. Events will include the following. All are invited!

**January 30:** During a special coffee hour, we will honor those who have served in a variety of leadership and service ministries at CCL, such as executive board, council, property, stewardship, mission, elders, finance, stationery, counters, nomination, hospitality, preservation, communication.

**February 27:** We will thank those who have faithfully served local ministries over many years, *Bearing the Name of Christ*, such as Meals on Wheels, Our Saviour's Shelter and Plymouth Christian Youth Center.

**March 6** (Transfiguration Sunday): Dr. Melinda Quivik will be in our midst to preach. She is a beloved former visitation pastor of our congregation who was instrumental in the prayer writing ministry done by laypeople. That same day, Dr. Fred Quivik will conduct our adult forum.

**March 27:** We will recognize those involved with the ministry of worship, including the choir, other musicians, altar guild, sacristan, assisting ministers, acolytes, lectors, prayer writers, ushers and greeters.

In May, we will ask you to schedule a time to have your photo taken at church for the centennial photo directory.


**May 15:** Those serving in educational ministries, such as preschool, adult education, youth, Sunday school and the nursery, will be lifted up.

**Saturday, November 19:** There will be a gala in our gymnasium, including a catered banquet, music and program—to be preceded by a social hour beginning at 4:00 p.m. This will be a ticketed event.

**November 20** (Christ the King Sunday) will be the culmination of our anniversary year. We are honored that theologian Dr. Martin Marty has agreed to preach at the 10:00 a.m. Eucharist. A reception will follow.

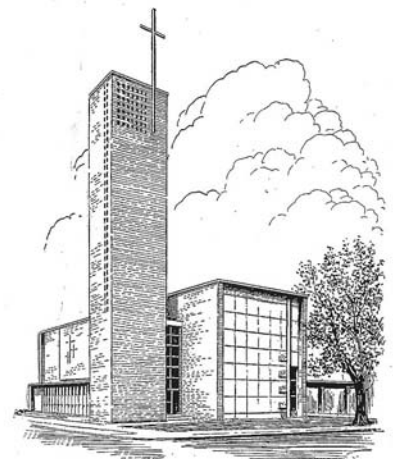

## Annual Giving Campaign from the Stewardship Committee

Thanks to everyone who turned in a 2011 commitment card. Your commitments give us a realistic idea of the ministry we can support, enabling us to be good stewards as we plan for a sustainable budget in 2011.

Here are a few notes from this campaign, as of the end of November 2010:

- Average household commitment is up for 2011, but fewer households have returned commitment cards.
- Total amount committed is less than last year (\$162,277 compared to \$184,160).
- One-third of the congregation uses *Simply Giving*.
- The number of households including Christ Church in their will or estate plan increased 120%.

We take heart in Jeremiah 29:11, which states, "For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope."

## Another Way to Give

In 2010, members of Thrivent Financial for Lutherans donated more than \$900 to Christ Church through the Thrivent Choice Dollars program. Christ Church Lutheran is the second highest recipient of these dollars in the city of Minneapolis!

## Summary of Council Meeting Minutes from November 9, 2010

**Missions:** To get an idea of who to call for help on particular community service projects, a one-page flyer will be available at church services for congregation members to complete to indicate areas of interest.

**Education:** Sunday school was held on November 7; a pick-up Christmas pageant will be held December 19, following coffee fellowship. Youth activities: Poinsettia delivery on November 28; Minneapolis area ELCA-sponsored Celebration of Compassion (Nuts for Nets) on November 10; PCYC service project.

**Stewardship:** The annual pledge drive is winding down. Thus far, 18 commitment cards have been returned for a total of \$82,000. Total pledges for 2010 were \$184,000.

**Worship** (reported by Pastor Carlson): There will be assistant minister and lector training this coming Sunday. Advent services will be held December 1, 8 and 15 at 11:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

**Treasurer's Report:** Checking account is balanced through the end of October. Investments did not increase as much as was reported last month; this had something to do with a stock sale. Envelope giving is lower than budgeted, but envelope income has picked up recently. Deficit as of end of October was about \$30,000.

- Discussion on how to best use memorial funds from Harriet Rabe's family. ELCA recommends that half of memorials go to the endowment account. Harriet was very involved with the food shelf. Motion: Split Harriet Rabe memorial funds 50/50 between endowment fund and mission fund. Motion carried.

**Pastor Carlson's Report:** Highlights of the last month include:

- All Saint's Sunday event at Central Lutheran was well-attended.
- Received an autographed book from Nick Hayes at the Friends' event. Would like the council to thank the Friends for the extraordinary efforts for the Nick Hayes event and for their effort curating the event.
- Harriet Rabe's funeral; working with her family was a privilege.
- Six or seven new members will join CCL on Christ the King Sunday. Music, worship and preaching have been a drawing card; they love the community.
- Looking ahead: Christ the King is the 99<sup>th</sup> birthday of CCL; looking forward to next year's many special events.

Joanne Seltz attended the council meeting, bringing a mosaic designed by Bob Rickels and given to the Kretzmans. Jeanette Kretzmann is donating the mosaic to CCL; it will be hung in the Kretzmann Library.

Joanne handed out the Conservation Easement Agreement, which has been approved by the Preservation Committee and the Property Committee. Motion: Move and second that we accept the Conservation Easement Agreement. Motion carried.

### Old Business

**Fundraising Update:** Karen Woestehoff is working on getting a report organized.

**Organ Project:** Nothing new to report at this time.

**100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary:** Committee requests \$12,000. Motion: Authorize the anniversary committee to spend the anniversary trust and use up to \$6,000 of endowment interest, as needed. Motion passed.

**Thrivent Line of Credit:** This document has been signed by Gene.

### New Business

**Proposal for Strategic Planning:** Still recruiting members; steering committee will be meeting soon.

**Congregation Meeting:** Will occur December 12 at 11:10 a.m. and include election of officers.

**Budget:** Kevin Olsen reviewed budget handouts and is requesting any feedback within the next few days; will have all figures up-to-date when executive board meets in three weeks. Motion: Council to give general approval to the budget, subject to final adjustments by the executive board. Motion passed.
